91X – New right main tire, aligned and balanced both main, new brake linings both mains, Right fuel tank reported as not venting, still has loaner radio in at no charge

29Q – IFR certification completed, taxi light replaced, master switch left on, IFR Certification rescheduled after battery was recharged, #2 radio works when turned on.

0YD –93 hours left on engine, seat rail issue is still an issue.

Please pay your bill by the 10th of the month following the closing of the billing period on the 25th. Otherwise you are subject to suspension, late fees and an invitation to attend a Board meeting

A REMINDER – CLEAN THE AIRCRAFT AFTER YOUR FLIGHT! The aircraft have all been cleaned, washed and waxed so please help keep them cleaned up. REMINDER or for those that do not know when cleaning the windshield and side windows on an aircraft DO NOT USE A CIRCULAR MOTION - YOU WILL RUIN THE PLEXAGLASS. Clean the surface using the cleaner provided and an up and down motion only. The weather is warming up so the bugs will be increasing, please clean and spray wax(do not wipe off the wax) the leading edges, clean the windshield and interior.

Several items of personal equipment have been left in the aircraft. If you have found or are missing anything, please e-mail the Secretary at weedoo@juno.com with a description of the item(s).

THE LOG SHEETS need your attention. Be sure you are signing on the log sheet for the aircraft you are going to fly. Double check you math and do not sign a log sheet for an aircraft you are not qualified to fly.
