A/C STATUS – as of 9-9-03 and updated as of 9-25-03

375 – New attitude indicator installed (\$490.00).went in for 100hr engine inspection and had prop AD taken care of.

686 – New turn coordinator, shock mounts on instrument panel installed and new transponder (\$1600.00).

64L– Carb heat cable replaced, 30+ hrs past TBO, new engine on order. Annual due at the end of September.

91X– Prop strike, a/c is grounded until further notice, waiting for insurance company to give us directions on how to proceed. We are looking at the possibility to zero time the engine for \$5,500.00. Annual due at the end of September.

29Q – okay

0YD –Engine passed TBO. We will have 25 hour oil changes and 50 hr engine inspections from now on until Engine change. Bid on rebuilt is \$17,000.00 plus removal, reinstall and prop work, replaced rotating beacon.

New carbon monoxide detectors will be installed as soon as they arrive.

A REMINDER – DO NOT FUEL 375 after your flight, fuel it before your flight. We can better manage weight and balance by calculating useable fuel before the flight. A fuel gauge is in the aircraft for you to see how much fuel is in the tanks.

ANOTHER REMINDER – please do not forget to **SIGN OUT THE AIRCRAFT** before you leave the building.

Ground School Refresher Classes will begin November 25, 2003 at 7 PM and will be on the third Tuesday each month for 1 hour each, everyone is welcome. Final details will be given at the meeting and a reminder will be sent before each meeting.
