64L – The engine break-in is in process now released for restricted flight by the membership. Please contact Jim Eyre for instructions if not clear. Some gold colored flakes showed up in the oil filter. Will be check again after 10hours

91X – finishing up tunnel repairs and stiffener installation on the firewall and then will hang the new engine.

29Q – reported with possible nose wheel shimmy. New brakes and tires installed.

0YD – new engine ordered. Annual scheduled for March 31 thru April 9th. The Board will present it’s recommendation for an assessment to finish paying for the engine, prop work and installation and misc. costs at the meeting.

Ground School Refresher Course will continue in March. Watch for meeting notice.
